- Minutes from November 6, 2002 meeting in Golden need to be approved.
- Minutes from December 4, 2002 Christmas party at MJB Sales approved.
- Website will be updated with approved minutes from September, October, November (pending approval), and December.
- We have received payment from Bob Smart for advertising in CBPA's advertising guide.
- Motion passed approving the payment of a portion of ABPA President Ron Chapman's travel expenses which he incurred attending CBPA's 2002 Annual Conference at the Arvada Center. The motion passed with the stipulation that all such charges be pre-approved by the membership in the future. The bill was for the amount of \$169.14.
- Judy Schmidt requested \$10 reimbursement for updating the CBPA's biannual report with the Colorado Secretary of State. Motion passed.
- The Advisory committee is currently evaluating three major national cross-connection control administration programs for the State of Colorado to adopt. Until a standard is agreed upon, water purveyors are being asked to grant a grace period between now and the months ahead for those testers who's certification expires before re-certification is possible. Details will be forthcoming.
- National has officially stated that they will now be collecting all the membership dues of ABPA members. This includes members of the CBPA. ABPA will then redistribute the local dues back to individual chapters on a quarterly basis. CBPA

would require monthly payments of membership dues rather than quarterly. In addition, “corporate” memberships which CBPA currently offers are not recognized by ABPA.

- On April 7th-11th, 2003, the cities of Colorado Springs, Fort Collins, Boulder/Longmont, and Grand Junction will be hosting tester training classes. A motion to involve CBPA with these workshops passed.
