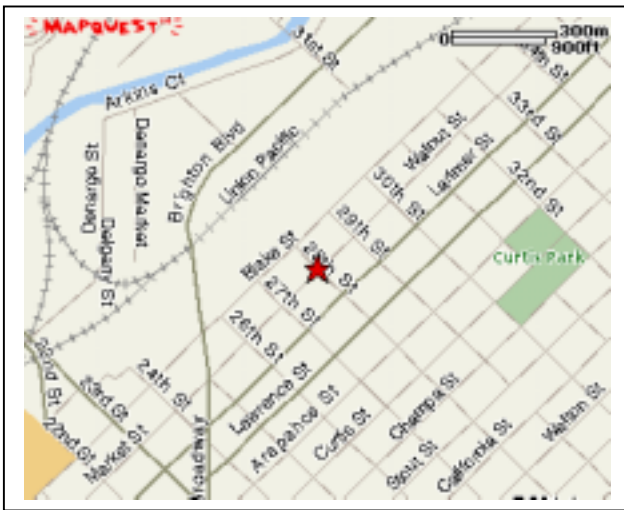

The First Colorado abpa technician & proctor certification held

The first ABPA certification exam was held in Aurora Colorado on June 6th 2003. Michael Moss the ABPA Region 5 Director and the Chair of the Training Committee (When he is not busy at the Utah Department of Environmental Quality) along with Greg Hand a Plumber and Instructor at Salt Lake Community College drove from Salt Lake City Utah to proctor the certification exam. They were joined by the other 1/3 of the Proctor and the Proctor Training Team Ken Ashlock, ABPA Past President, who flew in from Tempe Arizona for our historic occasion.

I believe that the trip was well worth it for Colorado as we now have a total of 21 certified ABPA Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester's in Colorado. CONGRATULATIONS TO ALL OF YOU! The three traveling proctors may have a different outlook. Just Kidding ☺

In addition to the Technician Certification a Proctor Training and Certification Exam was held on Saturday June 7th. The results are now in and there are a total of 9 Proctors in the State of Colorado. YEAH!

Additional dates for the ABPA Certification Exams that are currently planned for Colorado are: Aurora/Denver area Saturday Aug.23, 2003 Saturday Sept 20, 2003 in addition a date in conjunction with the December 4th CBPA Conference is planned for Wednesday Dec 3, 2003. Other locations in the State including a Western Slope or Grand Junction Exam may be scheduled as soon as the applications roll in.

Proctor Training is also planned for the CBPA Conference on December 4, 2003 if applications have been submitted at least 30 days prior to the conference date.

Please keep in mind those applications for the ABPA test and the Proctor training must be received by Mr. Ernest Havlina, Program Administrator at Least 30 days prior to the date of a scheduled exam.
