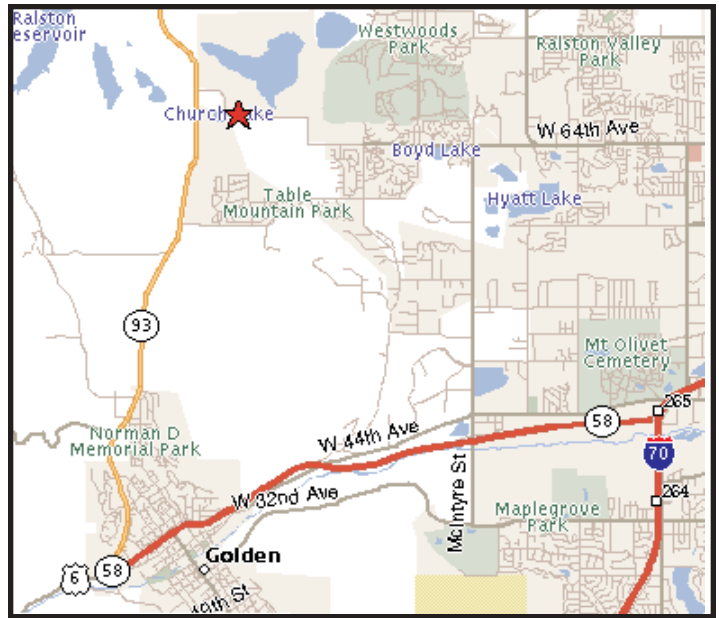
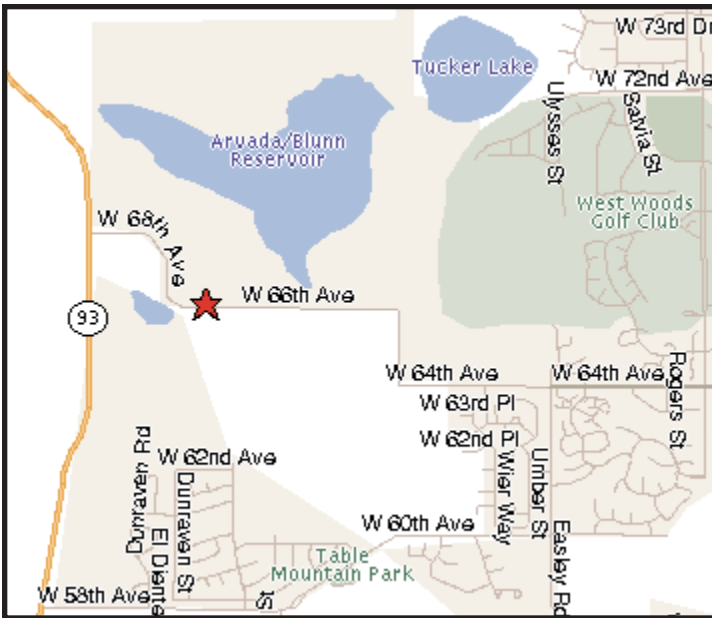
The City of Arvada first started this 9 MGD plant in 1959 and opened in 1962 with only three filters, chemical feed facilities, rapid mix and a reaction tank. Four major expansions have followed as the area grew quadrupling the plant capacity to 36 MGD. The recent 8 million dollar improvements added a flocculation / sedimentation building. With this conventional treatment, the water quality going onto the filters has a turbidity of 0.5 to 1.0 NTU. and the water leaving the plant has a turbidity of 0.02 NTU. This improvement has significantly improved the life of the filters and decreased the volume of backwash.

The City added the Arvada Water Treatment Plant in 1985. Together the plants have the capacity of 52 MGD with an expansion up to 68 MGD.

Merge onto CO-58 W.

Turn right onto CO-93.

Turn right onto W 68th Ave, W 68th Ave becomes W 66th Ave.

From the south:

Take I-25 North Take US-6 W / 6th Ave exit, exit number 209B

Merge onto US-6 / 6th Ave. Stay straight to go onto CO-93

Turn right onto W 68th Ave, W 68th Ave becomes W 66th Ave
