

CBPA Clean Up Day in Lakewood

A Fall clean up day has been scheduled for **November 11, 2006**. This clean up will take place along a waterway in Lakewood. According to the Lakewood Parks Department, there are trails, parkland, gulches and wetlands in the area we will be working.

For this clean up day, we are teamed up with the local chapter of the **International Order of the Rainbow For Girls**. This is a Masonic youth group, created to help girls, ages 11 through 20, with their transition into adults. This organization, among other things, performs different public service events throughout the year in their local area.

We will start on the West side of the area and work our way to the East. The area requiring clean up extends from Quail Street east to Sheridan Boulevard. We will begin work at 8:00 a.m. and finish at 12:00 noon, or earlier if weather or other conditions warrant.
