Colorado Springs Utilities annual orientation is scheduled for February 7, 2002 at the Leon Young Service Center, 1521 South Hancock Expressway. Orientation will run from 5-8pm in the Pikes Peak Conference Room. Attendance is mandatory to be considered for CSU's "2002 Approved List". Additionally, testers must provide proof of current state certification and current gauge calibrations for all gauges used. It is the tester's responsibility to provide and maintain current credentials on file with Colorado Springs Utilities. **CSU can not accept any test reports from any person until the above requirements are satisfied.**

Directions:

From I-25 take the US-24 E exit (exit # 139) towards Limon. Take the Union Blvd exit ramp and stay to the right. Make a right hand turn on to southbound Union Blvd and proceed to Hancock Expressway (about 1 mile). Make another right hand turn on to Hancock Expressway. Stay on Hancock Expressway under the US-24 overpass and look for the Leon Young Service Center on your right hand side. Park in the North Lot and go in the main entrance.
