Testers under this program should be able to carry out all duties and responsibilities associated with being a backflow prevention assembly tester, have a high school diploma or GED and have reached to proper age requirements as needed in jurisdiction where working. An ABPA certification is good for three years. A separate registration form is required for the class and the test. Paperwork **MUST** be received two weeks prior to the start of class. 4.0 CEUs

ABPA Recertification Review Course

Participants will be presented with information necessary to pass the ABPA Recertification test. It is the responsibility of the tester to apply for recertification. The written test for recertification is comprised of trouble shooting and test procedures. The applicant shall be required to successfully complete a written test and performance examination. The performance exam consists of four assemblies: DC, RP, PVB, and SVB. A separate application is required for the review course and the test. All paperwork **MUST** be received two weeks prior to the course date.

ABPA Certification and Recertification Test

The ABPA Test consists of two parts; a closed book written exam and an individual hands-on performance exam. The performance exam requires that you successfully demonstrate field test procedures for the following: RP, DC, PVB, and SVB. The applicant is expected to be capable of diagnosing the condition of the assemblies when they work properly and when there is a malfunction. A separate application is required for the review course and the test. All paperwork **MUST** be received two weeks prior to the course date.

40-Hour ASSE Cross-Connection Control Technician

Participants will be presented with the guidelines used for acceptable practices of testing backflow prevention devices. The participants will also learn the principles of cross-connection control, and the methods and devices used to prevent backflow of undesirable substances into water distribution and plumbing systems carrying potable water. Upon completion of the course, the participant will have sufficient information and skills to pass the American Society of Sanitary Engineering (ASSE) Examination. The Rocky Mountain Education Center is an ASSE approved testing site. Please note: if you plan on taking the certification examination, you will need to register for the CETC 161 Course and complete a separate test application. This paperwork **MUST** be received two weeks prior to the start of the course. This certification is in compliance with Article 12-Hazardous Cross-Connection of the Drinking Water Regulations.

ASSE Cross-Connection Control Certification

American Society of Sanitary Engineering technician certification is a national certification. The testing involves a written test and a hands-on examination. Both tests need to be passed in order to receive initial certification. The ASSE certification is good for three years. A separate test application is required and applications **MUST** be post-marked no later than two weeks prior to the course date. A mandatory 40-hour course is required to take the ASSE initial certification test. The certification will consist of a 100 question written test and a hands-on examination. A 70% passing score on the written exam and knowledge of hands-on experience is necessary to receive certification. This certification is in compliance with Article 12-Hazardous Cross-Connection of the Drinking Water Regulations.

ASSE Cross-Connection Control Technician Re-Certification

ASSE certification expires in three years. You may recertify on any of the scheduled test dates in the final year of your certification. Recertification must be completed prior to the technician expiration date on your card and certificate to meet certain local backflow prevention program regulations. If your technician certification expires and you have not recertified, the only way to reinstate your certification is to take the complete initial examination at a designated test site. The test will consist of a 25 question written test and a hands-on examination. A 70% minimum passing score is necessary to receive an updated certificate and a non-picture I.D. card. A separate test application is required and applications **MUST** be postmarked no later than two-weeks prior to the day of the course date you select.

ASSE Cross-Connection Control Review

Participants will be presented with the guidelines used for acceptable practices of testing backflow prevention devices. Areas of the course will include: regulations, statutes, ordinances and codes, knowledge of the principles and operations of test gauges, knowledge of proper testing of backflow preventers, troubleshooting backflow preventers, and responsibilities of the general tester. This course is mandatory in order for the tester to recertify under ASSE general guidelines. Registration and application for testing **MUST** be received two-weeks prior to the course date.
